POST-NEUROMODULATOR (BOTOX) TREATMENT

TREATMENT FOLLOWING BOTOX COSMETIC TREATMENTS

- Do not exercise right after a treatment. Plan on exercising prior to the treatment or the day after.
- Do not massage or manipulate the injection sites for 48 hours after injection.
- If bruising occurs, it may be covered up with makeup. Bruises usually resolve in just a few days, but it may take up to 2 weeks. Auriderm gel is available for purchase at Sand Lake Dermatology Center and may be applied 2-4 times daily to help alleviate bruising.
- It will take 4-7 days for you to see results and up to 2 weeks for peak effect.
- A follow-up appointment is usually recommended 2 weeks post-treatment to ensure satisfactory results. If after 2 weeks, you have any concerns, please contact the office. Sometimes, a small amount of additional Botox may be needed to achieve the desired results.
- Botox appointments are ideally scheduled 3 months apart. The interval between appointments can be gradually lengthened over time. It is ideal to have another treatment before you completely return to baseline. We find that this may improve and maintain the results longer in subsequent treatments.
